- You must have excellent organisational and project management skills which will be utilised to help run our grand prix tournaments, coaching programmes, coaching courses etc.
- Your administration skills will allow you to write press releases, manage our county ranking scheme, re-establish our junior team leagues etc.
- You will need to be highly self-motivated and be proactive so as to maximise opportunities for Norfolk Junior Squash
- You should have the confidence to be able to seek sponsorship and funding opportunities to help develop Norfolk Junior Squash
- You should be able to inspire all individuals to fulfil their potential by acting as a positive role model.
- You should be able to co-ordinate, motivate and increase our volunteer base
- Your enthusiasm should know no bounds and this should be coupled with excellent leadership skills, so as to establish Norfolk as one of the best counties for squash in England.

Initially, we are looking to work with an individual for eight hours a week (flexible working arrangements) on a consultancy basis. This will be for a trial period of six months upon which a review of targets will take place.
